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STEP

Successfully complete the Certificate of Registration with ASTC.

- Register with NSW Fair Trading as an Assistant Agent (Class 3)
- Work under the supervision of a Class 1 licence holder.
- *Note: All Assistant Agents are required to transition to a class 2 licence in the 4 years after the commencement of the Reforms

STEP

Successfully complete the CPP41419 Certificate IV in Real Estate practice with ASTC.

- As a registration Assistant Agent, complete a minimum of one year working in the property industry.
- Provide NSW Fair Trading with evidence of competence from the work experience requirements nominated.
- Register with NSW Fair Trading as a Licensed Agent (class 2)
- Work under the supervision of a class 1 licence holder

STEP

Successfully complete the Diploma of Property Services (Agency Management) with ASTC.

- As a registered Licensed Agent, complete a minimum of two years working in the property industry.
- Provide NSW Fair Trading with evidence of competence from the work experience requirements nominated.

Register with NSW Fair Trading as a Licensee-in-charge (class 1)

Choose to either:

- a) Work under the supervision of a class 1 licence holder
 - OR
- b) Operate your own agency
- C) work as an independence





Take the next step in your career

If you want to climb the property ladder and operate as an Independent Contractor, operate your own office, or act as the Licensee-In-Charge of an office when your LIC is absent from the office, you will require a Class 1 Licence

To obtain a Class 1 licence you will need to work as a Class 2 Licensed Agent for 2 years and you will also need to complete the Diploma of Property (Agency Management) qualification.

So once you've completed your Certificate IV in Real Estate Practice qualification, start on the path to becoming the professional you NEED to be, and commence the Diploma program to enhance your skills, knowledge, and opportunities in the property industry.
